



**The Great Chesapeake Bay Swim – ONE MILE BAY CHALLENGE
TIMELINE – EVENT DAY INSTRUCTIONS FOR
SWIMMERS & SPECTATORS**

June 11, 2017

Hemingway's Marina at the Bay Bridge Marina, Eastern Shores of the Twin Bridges, Exit 37 S. off Rt. 50, Pier One Road, Stevensville, MD 21666

ALL 4.4 & ONE Mile SWIMMERS & SPECTATORS ARE TO FOLLOW MANDATORY PARKING INSTRUCTIONS. There are two parking sites: Buses will have signs in front windows: 4.4 SWIM AND . . .

ONE MILE SWIM BUSES WHICH ARE FOR ALL SPECTATORS AND ONE MILE SWIMMERS PLUS ANY OVERFLOW PARKING FROM THE Park & Ride lot.

-- **Note: Only 4.4 swimmers are permitted on the 4.4 signed buses!** They will be going back and forth to Sandy Point State Park with 4.4 swimmers for swim check in, and swim start. **Once the 4.4 swim starts, the 4.4 buses do not return to Sandy Point State Park.**

1. **Park & Ride lot on Rt. 8** (directional signs will be posted pointing to entrance.) **Matapeake Elementary & Middle Schools** – just continue on Rt. 8-Romancoke Rd. to the schools. The last page of this timeline contains a directional map link.

PARKING INSTRUCTIONS – No pets permitted on shuttle buses.

- Athletes for the **Great Chesapeake Bay Swim 4.4** should utilize the **Park and Ride on Rt. 8**, and board the appropriate 4.4 signed bus for transport to Sandy Point State Park.
- **Overflow 4.4, and One Mile Chesapeake Challenge athletes, and spectator parking will be located at Matapeake Elementary and Middle Schools – just follow Rt. 8 / Romancoke Rd. Follow posted signs.**
- **Shuttle Buses will provide transportation throughout event day and will continuously loop from the spectator parking areas to the Park and Ride & Matapeake Elementary and Middle Schools, and then to the drop off point at Bay Bridge Marina.** All parking is free of charge.

THERE WILL BE NO ATHLETE OR SPECTATOR PARKING AT BAY BRIDGE MARINA. ATHLETE AND SPECTATOR VEHICLES WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM DRIVING DOWN PIER ONE ROAD TO THE MARINA. DO NOT PARK ON ANY ROAD SHOULDERS – YOU WILL BE SUBJECT TO TICKETING.

ONE MILE TIMELINE WITH CHECK-IN INFO. & SWIM STARTS:

5:30 AM Signed One Mile shuttle buses ready to begin transport to Hemingways Marina staging area next to the twin bridges on the eastern shores.

6:30 AM Volunteer personnel on site

7:00 – 8:00 AM Registration/check-in set up and ready. Under pop-ups facing the water.

Packet Pick-Up, Body Marking. Photo ID mandatory!

-- This includes parent/guardian accompanying swimmers under 18 yrs. old! Minor's may use school i.d. or copy of birth certificate.

After receiving your swim packet please go directly to the body numbering volunteers next to the check-in tables. No Photo I.D. – No Swim. This includes parents/guardians for youth swimmers presenting their swimmer at check-in.

In Your Swim Packet: ANKLE STRAP TIMING CHIP. IF WEARING A FULL WET SUIT, WEAR ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE PANT LEG! Wave colored, assigned numbered swim cap. Race bib with tear off numbered strip. Remove strip, and put it on top of your head, then put your swim cap on – MUST WEAR!

8:00 AM **Pre-Race Meeting:** Swimmers will line up in swim wave order. Each wave has its own wave color. After the GCBS April 15th refund deadline, an email blast will be sent out, and posted containing swimmers wave and wave cap colors.

The one mile swim has the same start and finish area on the small beach within the secured swim area. It will be an in water start. The swim course is triangle shaped. In water support will be on course. Spectators will have an excellent view of the venue from the bluff in front of the tented area, overlooking the bay and bridge.

8:15 AM **Race Start**

8:15 AM **1ST Wave Starts:** **Wave 1 Cutoff - 9:30**

8:20 AM **2ND Wave Starts:** **Wave 2 Cutoff - 9:35**

8:25 AM **3RD Wave Starts:** **Wave 3 Cutoff - 9:40**

8:30 AM **4TH Wave Starts:** **Wave 4 Cutoff – 9:45**

9:45 AM **Race Finish**

10:20 AM **Awards Ceremony**

FYI: Mile 1 – Time Cutoff – any swimmers not making their swim wave cut-off time will be removed from the water by in-water support boat authorized personnel.

- Your swim cap, and timing band will be removed as you are being transported back to Hemingway’s Marina. It will be given to LINMARK timer as proof that the swimmer was removed from the water. This procedure will take place for each wave cutoff time listed above.

- Many choose to remain and watch when the 4.4 swimmers come onto the same finish lines area as they return to the eastern shores from under the span of the twin bridges. There will be DJ music, food vendors, sponsors on site, and GCBS items for sale.
- NO SMOKING IN VENUE AREA. Please go out into the parking lot area.
- **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PERMITTED ON HEMINGWAY’S MARINA.** They will have beer, and other beverages available for sale.
- **SWIM DAY RESULTS:** Will be available on Chrome notebooks next to the LINMARK Sports timing van, parked behind the check-in pop up tented area. Finish times will also be featured on the LINMARK Sports web home page, just click on the Results button at the page header. RESULTS WILL ALSO BE ONGOING TEXTED TO YOUR CELL PHONE IF included on your entry form info.

You will also be able to view the secondary parking area to utilize - as the Stevensville Park and Ride Lot will fill up. You will proceed down on Rt. 8/Romance Rd. to the parking lot at the Metapeake School. The shuttle buses will be doing pick up and drop offs thru event day.
